THE LITURGICAL YEAR

The Riverside Church follows the liturgical calendar to mark the seasons of our life together. We are currently in the season of Eastertide, a period of 50 days following the resurrection of Jesus Christ until Pentecost. The liturgical color of Eastertide is white, which symbolizes the hope of the resurrection, as well as the purity and newness that comes from victory over sin and death, as signified by the paraments and clergy stoles.

On Sunday, June 4 we will be celebrating Pentecost. Everyone is invited to wear red to signify the work of the Holy Spirit in our lives and in our world.

Complete a Welcome Card and place it in the offering plate as it passes.

Join us for Fellowship Hour in Assembly Hall directly after Worship. As you leave the Nave, take the stairs or elevator down to the A level. Greeters are available to provide direction. You'll find fair trade coffee from Javesca Coffee, a children's play area, a greeting area to learn about membership at Riverside, and indoor seating.

A church tour is offered each Sunday after Worship free of charge. Meet in the 1st balcony. Tours also take place on Wednesdays, Thursdays, and Saturdays at 1:00 p.m. and 3:00 p.m. leaving from the Gift Shop. No reservations are necessary.
