Originally from Washington DC, Rev. Palmer is a second career minister, attending Seminary after a fifteen-year career as a broadcasting executive with CBS

Inc. Rev. Palmer's educational background includes a BA in Economics from Swarthmore College, an MBA from the University of Pennsylvania, and a Master's in Divinity with Honors from New York Theological Seminary. A longtime member of the Inspirational Choir, Rev. Palmer was ordained at Riverside in 2004 to his first call as an Associate Minister at Middle Collegiate Church in Manhattan. After living twenty years in Jersey City, Rev. Palmer relocated with his spouse Donald, an ordained ELCA minister, to Baltimore MD, where they welcomed their seven-month-old puppy Pooh.


