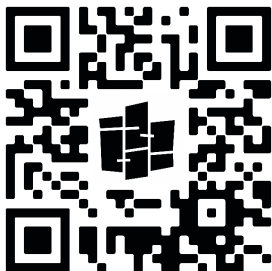

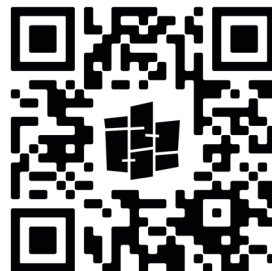

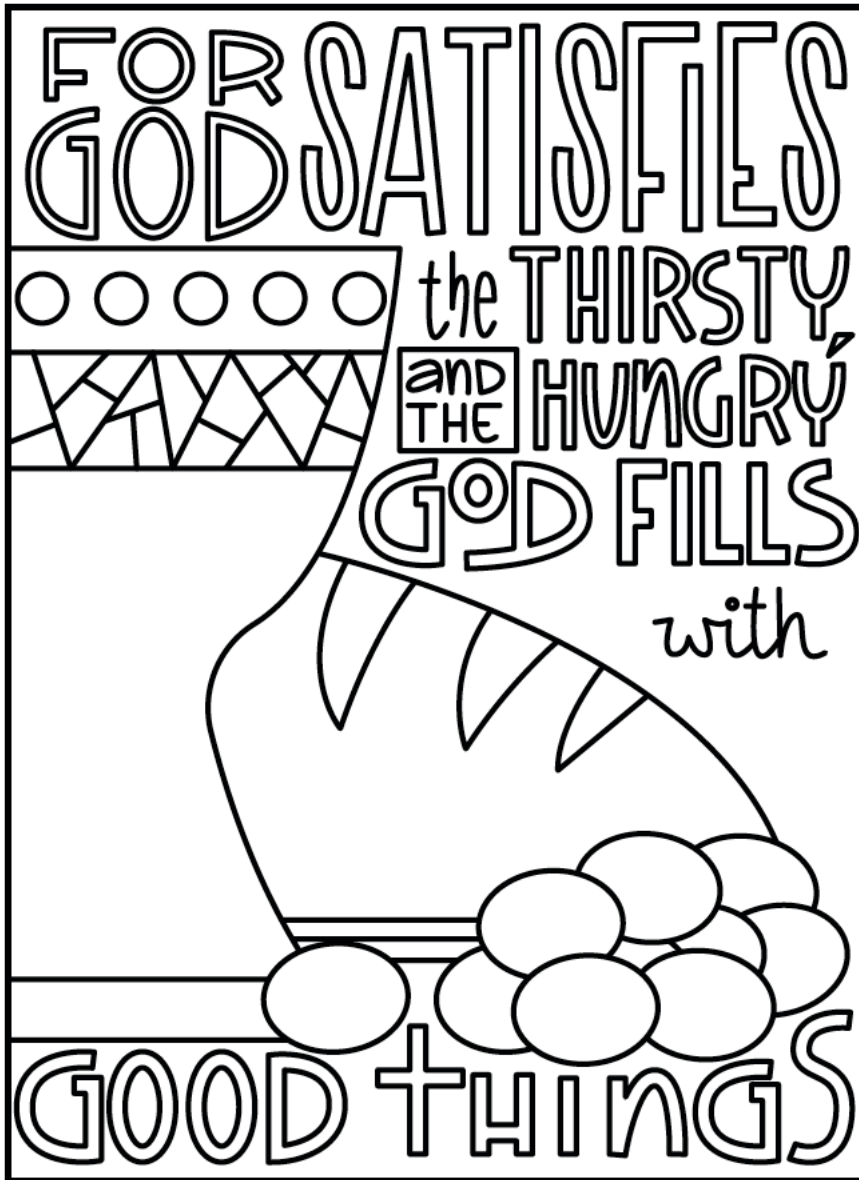


Lee Sartain recently concluded his service to Riverside Church on the Senior Minister Search Committee, and is actively involved with the Real Estate Assessment Subcommittee of the Riverside Development Committee.

Lee spent 15 years in senior leadership at North Carolina State University and Union Theological Seminary--last serving as Strategic Advisor for Finance and New Partnerships at Union. In North Carolina, he also served as a Commissioned Pastor of a Presbyterian (PCUSA) new worshipping community, East Raleigh Fellowship, as well as in interim ministry at Pullen Memorial Baptist Church, both in Raleigh. Lee has served on the board of the Association of Welcoming and Affirming Baptists. As a seminary student, he served as a consultant on a Lilly Endowment funded initiative focused on congregational vitality and financial wellness with the Episcopal Church Foundation. Lee holds degrees in religious studies from North Carolina State University and social ethics from Union Theological Seminary and is currently completing a degree in finance at Harvard University.

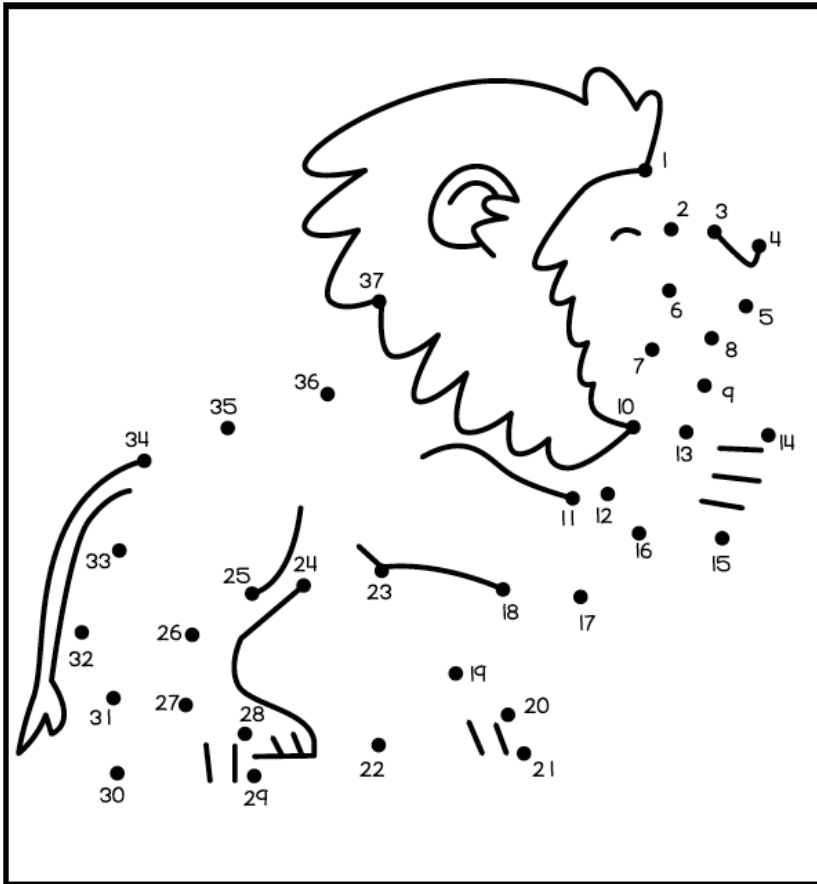
