






Rev. Kevin W. VanHook, II, is a dynamic preacher, community activist, and transformative leader called by God to proclaim Biblical truth, advance social justice, and transform communities. Often described as an energetic servant-leader deeply committed to pursuing innovative approaches to spiritual and social transformation, Rev. VanHook currently serves as the Executive Director of Episcopal Charities of New York (ECNY) where he leads a community of one hundred transformative outreach programs that serve over 1 million New Yorkers each year. In that role, he has spearheaded efforts to successfully launch and scale ECNY's first three internally-run programs and secured the highest fundraising year in the organization's history within his first twelve months on post. During his time at ECNY, Rev. VanHook has continued to play a key role congregational worship life by preaching in many of the leading pulpits throughout New York and the nation. Prior to leading ECNY, he served as the Minister of Justice, Advocacy, and Change at the historic Riverside Church in the City of New York, where he led the church's twenty-two active social justice ministry initiatives by designing innovative programs focused on pursuing justice. Additionally, he has led and served as the Executive Officer of a groundbreaking continuing education program at Princeton Theological Seminary, the Minister to Youth and Young Adults of a thriving multilingual congregation in New Jersey, and as an Air Force officer leading several multidisciplinary teams on high-profile projects and programs in the space industry.

Originally from Waco, Texas, Rev. VanHook is a graduate of the United States Air Force Academy (where he served as the Cadet Wing Commander, the highest-ranking position in the student-body, and received the school's highest honor), the University of Denver, and Princeton Theological Seminary, where he was distinguished as one of the most gifted preachers in his graduating class as the recipient of the Kenyon J. Wildrick Award for Excellence in Homiletics. He is currently pursuing a Ph.D. from Pepperdine University, where his research focuses on the intersection of faith, justice, and social transformation. To this end, Rev. VanHook has a successful track record of building dynamic teams of leaders within faith communities that successfully work to make multiple transformative, justice-centered impacts at both the local and national levels in fresh and creative ways. Rev. VanHook currently resides in New Jersey with his wife, Vicki, and their two children, Olivia and Cooper.
