

THE INSTALLATION PREACHER

The Reverend Barbara J. Essex



The Reverend Barbara J. Essex is a retired minister of the United Church of Christ (UCC). She is an author, teacher, consultant, and retreat and workshop facilitator. As founder of Barbara J. Essex Ministries, she has established strong relationships with a diverse range of congregations, regional and national judicatories, colleges, universities and seminaries. Her work is ecumenical, biblically-based, and theologically and socially progressive.

Rev. Essex's ministry has taken her across the globe and she has served in a variety of settings: local church, campus ministry, denominational, and higher education. Most recently, she was adjunct faculty for the Hartford Seminary Women's Leadership Institute (the seminary is now the Hartford International University for Religion and Peace; Hartford, CT). She continues to teach for Pacific School of Religion's Theological Education for Leadership Program (Berkeley, CA).

The best-selling author received a Pilgrim Press Mayflower Award for Spirituality for her book, Bad Boys of the Bible: Exploring Men of Questionable Virtue. Some of her popular works include: Bad Girls of the Bible: Exploring Women of Questionable Virtue; Krazy Kinfolk: Exploring Dysfunctional Families in the Bible; Misbehavin' Monarchs: Exploring Biblical Monarchs; More Bad Girls of the Bible; Bold and Brazen: Exploring Hebrew Prophets, and Girlfriends: Exploring Women's Relationships in the Bible. Her books are making a difference in how we study the Bible and how we view ourselves as children of God. Her articles and essays have appeared in various publications, including biblical commentaries.

Before entering the ministry, Rev. Essex taught English and Reading to high school students in the Chicago Public School System. She has earned degrees from Northwestern University and Garrett-Evangelical Theological Seminary, both in Evanston, IL.

Rev. Essex is a member of Mt. Zion (Congregational) UCC in Cleveland, and an associate member of Sycamore UCC in El Cerrito, CA.

THE SENIOR MINISTER

The Reverend Adriene Thorne

The Reverend Adriene Thorne is the eighth senior minister of the historic Riverside Church in the City of New York and the first African American woman to hold the position. She received her Master of Divinity degree from The Pacific School of Religion and completed postgraduate studies in pastoral care and counseling at The Blanton-Peale Institute.

Rev. Thorne is a healer, Presbyterian minister, and classically trained dancer who uses movement to heal bodies in the church and community. When she is feeling open, though, Rev. Thorne will tell you that she has learned more about God from nature, art, and her child than from any classroom or book.

Rev. Thorne's background in the performing arts includes credits with The Dance Theatre of Harlem, The Metropolitan Opera, and the world-famous Radio City Rockettes among others. When she is not parenting, pastoring, creating, or mentoring, Rev. Thorne is probably SCUBA diving a coral reef, on the squash court, or in the dance studio, fantasizing about what is newly possible. Rev. Thorne grounds her Christian practice and leadership in an appreciation for imperfection and leads with an understanding that even the resurrected Christ came back in a flawed body – what hopeful news for us!
