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Frequently Asked Questions

Is the Career Day Scholarship Award for High School students only?

Yes, this award is for high school sophomore, junior, or seniors.

What is the deadline for submitting applications?

The Career Day Scholarship Award requires that all materials be mailed in one packet and received by Monday, April 4th, 2022.

When can we expect to hear something back on the status of the application?

Finalists will be selected by April 22th, 2022. The winners will be announced during the Career Day Event on May 14th 2022. If you are not present, you forfeit the scholarship award.

When is the letter of recommendation, school transcripts, and school profile due? Can they be sent separately from my application?

All application materials, including the letter of recommendation, school transcripts, and school profile, must be mailed in one packet and received by Monday, April 4th, 2022. Please ensure your scholarship packet is complete prior to mailing, as incomplete, e-mailed, or faxed applications will not be evaluated.

Does my letter of recommendation have to be written by teachers, or can they come from anyone?

We ask for one letter of recommendation. A person who knows you well must write it. This person should be a teacher, school counselor, volunteer supervisor, clergy member, or an employer. It could also be an extracurricular adult leader, or an athletic coach.
