Rev. Charles King is one of the founders and serves as the Chief Executive Officer of Housing Works, a community-based non-profit organization established in 1990, to provide housing for homeless people living with AIDS and HIV. Today, most known for its chain of thrift stores and used bookstore care, Housing Works serves over 15,000 of the most marginalized New Yorkers, operating four health centers, nearly 800 units of permanent and transitional

housing, behavioral health services, including syringe exchange and overdose prevention, vocational opportunity, legal services and relentless advocacy.

Charles holds both a Master of Divinity and a Juris Doctorate from Yale University. He was ordained at Immanuel Missionary Baptist Church in New Haven, Connecticut, where he served as the Assistant Pastor for three years in the mid-1980's. He started attending Riverside more than three years ago and serves as co-chair of the Riverside Development Committee. Over the years, Charles has helped to parent four boys, Jimmy, Shaquille, Yojancer, and Emilio, all now young men who consider him to be their father and who are his greatest joy.
