Elinor Fosdick Downs American pediatrician and medical officer in the maternal and child health sector of the WHO, and daughter of Riverside's Rev. Dr. Harry Emerson Fosdick.

Sharice Davids American attorney, former mixed martial artist, and politician serving as the U.S. Representative from Kansas, and the first openly LGBT Native American elected to the U.S.
